6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Corporate Services Department, Town Hall, St Helens, Merseyside WA10 1HP by **5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019**.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Corporate Services Department, Town Hall, St Helens, Merseyside WA10 1HP by **5 pm on Thursday, 2nd May 2019**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019.
